Roster Days

A couple of year's ago a roster was set up to try to deal with the issue of having enough Officials at every meeting and to date, it has worked reasonably well, but it does come unstuck regularly when people don't turn up when they are rostered on.

If people don't want to do their roster day themselves, they have the option of organising someone else to do it for them!. The only limitations is the person needs to be over 16 years old, must wear closed in shoes and be willing to carry out the duty for the whole day. However, don't expect our Secretary to organise this for you, it's your responsibility.

The other issue that makes it difficult is when people ask Officials who are already doing a job to do their roster day for them, this doesn't work as that Official already has a role to do and can't do two jobs at the same time, which still leaves a position without someone to do it.

As you are all aware, there has always been many more members than jobs to do, so not everyone is put on the roster each year. If you are on the roster this year, you won't be in the cycle again until everyone has done a day. Serious consideration will be given for next year to increase the number of people who are rostered on each race day, which will help to take the pressure off the volunteers that help out at each meeting
