As most of you will know, we have had a fight, literally for our karting lives this year, in the battle over the introduction of compulsory clutches, particularly in our senior classes.

It has taken both speedway Clubs all year to get our cause heard by the AKA, but thankfully as of last Saturday, we finally have an outcome that will mean that speedway will continue to be a financially viable option for those who wish to continue to compete in our affordable motorsport. Compulsory Clubman Clutch Update

After 12 months of very hard work carried out by both CCSKC and NSWSKC, we jointly took our issues to the State Karting Council yesterday and we are proud to announce that the following information about clutch implementation for 2009.

Midget / Rookies / Juniors - Clutches will become compulsory from 1st Jan 2009

All Clubman Classes

All Short Shaft Motors - Clutches will become compulsory from 1st Jan 2009 as there are a number of brands currently approved for use.

All Long Shaft Motors using 10 tooth sprockets or bigger - Clutches will become compulsory from 1st Jan 2009

All Long Shaft Motors using 9 tooth sprockets - A 12 month delay has been approved due to production and homologation delays. With the planned introduction date of 1st Jan 2010.

ALL KT AND 0-100 CLASSES - HAVE BEEN GIVEN A PERMANENT EXEMPTION FROM COMPULSORY CLUTCHES.

We see it as a win/win for everyone as it provides an avenue for those in Clubman who have/or want clutches to compete together if they wish, but also leaves open options for those who don't to still compete as well.

Both Clubs will be reviewing our Competition Classes for the 2009 racing season to reflect these changes as well.

An updated version of Chapter 48 has been submitted jointly by NSWSKC and CCSKC for inclusion in the 2009 Karting Manual reflecting these changes.

Suggested CCSKC Competition Classes for 2009

- Midgets
- Rookies
- Juniors - Light - Heavy - or Combined - depending on numbers
- Clubman - Light - Heavy - or Combined
- KT Standard - Light
- KT Standard - Heavy
- KT Standard - Over 40
- KT Modified - Light - Heavy - or Combined - depending on numbers

Differences between KT Standard and Modified would need to be worked out but could probably be based around engine modification guidelines. Both would be able to run KT exhaust and airbox rules.

Further information will be released shortly to confirm classes and specifications.

Sports Rage and Unacceptable Behaviour

Our Club would like to remind everyone that there is a minimum standard of acceptable behaviour at all times at our Club for everyone.

Please remember that you aren't racing for a million dollars or a sheep station... you are racing for enjoyment.

Amongst other things, like the reputation of our Club and yourself, think about the negative affect this type of behaviour is having on the kids - it is never acceptable under any circumstances.

So to spell it out in plain English - the following types of behaviour (this is just a suggestion of some of the things and is not a complete list) will NOT be accepted and will be dealt with very harshly:

- Swearing
- Abuse
- Physical violence or threats of violence
- Intimidation
- Throwing helmets or other things
- Temper tantrums
- Tampering with other people's equipment
- Theft

Remember, if you have a problem then deal with it through the appropriate channels, and show the same level of respect to others that you expect to be shown to you.

The Stewards of the Meeting have the ability to not only issue an appropriate AKA level penalty, but also can have a person/s removed from the circuit and/or call the NSW Police in, which may result in a criminal charge.

We are no longer going to accept anything less than polite, courteous, and respectful behaviour and those who ignore this warning will be penalised very harshly.

2008 Duty Roster

1. CAN I HAVE SOMEONE WHO IS ALREADY ROSTERED ON FOR THE MEETING DO MY DUTY FOR ME?
*A. NO. People already scheduled to work (either on the Roster or as an Official) at a Race Meeting are **NOT PERMITTED** to carry out additional Roster Duties for other people during that Race Meeting.*
2. **WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I FAIL TO COMPLETE MY ROSTER DUTY?**
A. You will not be permitted to compete at any CCSKC race meetings until a Duty is done.
3. HOW CAN I COMPLETE MY ROSTER DAY BUT STILL RACE?
A. You may have another person do your Roster Duty for you, but they must be over 16. You have to arrange it yourself and notify the Club Secretary one (1) week prior to the race meeting it affects.
4. CAN I SWAP DAYS WITH SOMEONE ELSE ON THE ROSTER?
*A. Yes you may swap Roster Duty dates with other Members on the Roster; however you have to arrange this yourself and notify the Club Secretary prior to the race meeting it affects. **WE WILL NOT ARRANGE IT FOR YOU.***
5. I'M NOT 16 WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I'M ROSTERED ON?
A. Parents or others over 16 will carry out the Roster Duty for all competitors under 16.
6. I'M NOT 16 BUT MY PARENT/GUARDIAN REGULARLY WORKS AS AN OFFICIAL/VOLUNTEER ON RACE DAYS - DO I STILL GO ON THE ROSTER?
A. Children under 16 of our regular Officials/Volunteers will not be included on the roster as a reward for their continuing support; however when they turn 16 they will be included on the Roster.
7. WHAT DO I DO WHEN I ARRIVE AT THE TRACK FOR MY ROSTER DUTY?
A. Please report to the Race Office by no later than 8.00am on the morning you are Rostered on and jobs will be distributed then. You must wear solid closed in shoes for all duties.
8. WHAT HAPPENS IF THE RACE MEETING IS POSTPONED?
A. In the event of a Race Meeting being postponed, your Roster Duty will move with the Race Meeting.
9. CAN I PRE-ARRANGE A SPECIFIC JOB FOR MY ROSTER DUTY?
A. If you have a preferred job, you can contact the Secretary as soon as possible before Race Day and reserve that job.
10. WHAT DO I DO IF I DON'T KNOW HOW TO DO THE JOB ALLOCATED?
A. Written description and instructions are available from the Race Office for each job, plus the Clerk of Course will ensure that you are familiar with the requirements for each job at the Officials Briefing prior to the commencement of racing.
11. WHAT DO I DO IF I'M NOT SURE I'M DOING THE RIGHT THING?
A. If at any time during the meeting (except during a race) you have any doubts or questions you may contact either the Clerk of Course, Chief Steward or Race Office via your radio for assistance.
12. WHAT JOBS ARE ON THE ROSTER?
A. Roster Duty Positions include but is not limited too:
 - Flags x 4
 - Grid Marshall
 - Weigh Marshall

The top 3 point scorers in each class with receive prestige trophies. All other competitors will also receive a trophy as well, so no one misses out.

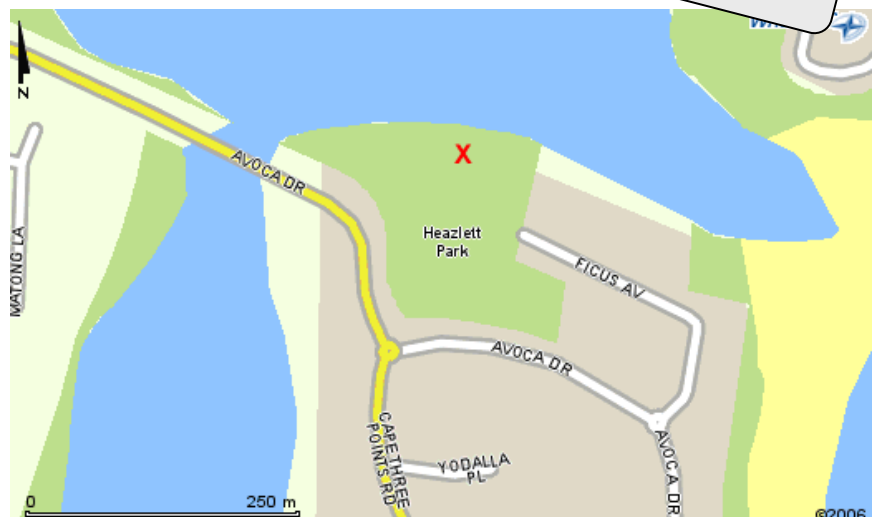
