## Sports Rage and Unacceptable Behaviour

Our Club would like to remind everyone once again for the start of the new season, that there is a minimum standard of acceptable behaviour at all times at our Club for everyone.

Please remember that you aren't racing for a million dollars or a sheep station... you are racing for enjoyment.

Amongst other things, like the reputation of our Club and yourself, think about the negative affect this type of behaviour is having on the kids - it is never acceptable under any circumstances.

So to spell it out in plain English - the following types of behaviour (this is just a suggestion of some of the things and is not a complete list) will NOT be accepted and will be dealt with very harshly:

- Swearing
- Abuse
- Physical violence or threats of violence
- Intimidation
- Throwing helmets or other things
- Temper tantrums
- Tampering with other people's equipment
- Theft

Remember, if you have a problem then deal with it through the appropriate channels, and show the same level of respect to others that you expect to be shown to you.

The Stewards of the Meeting have the ability to not only issue an appropriate AKA level penalty, but also can have a person/s removed from the circuit and/or call the NSW Police in, which may result in a criminal charge.

**We are no longer going to accept anything less than polite, courteous, and respectful behaviour and those who ignore this warning will be penalised very harshly.**

### 1. WHO DO I SPEAK TO IF I HAVE ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT THE ROSTER?

*All Roster enquiries must go to Tanya Bailey. Ph: 02 4357 1958 Email: [raceseecretary@ccskc.com.au](mailto:raceseecretary@ccskc.com.au)*

### 2. CAN I HAVE SOMEONE WHO IS ALREADY ROSTERED ON FOR THE MEETING DO MY DUTY FOR ME? **NO.**

*People already working at a Race Meeting (either on the Roster or an Official) are **NOT PERMITTED** to carry out additional Roster Duties for other people*

### 3. WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I FAIL TO COMPLETE MY ROSTER DUTY?

*You will not be permitted to compete at any CCSKC race meetings until a Duty is done.*

### 4. HOW CAN I COMPLETE MY ROSTER DAY BUT STILL RACE?

*You may have another person do your Roster Duty for you, but they must be over **18**, but you have to arrange it and notify Tanya Bailey.*

### 5. CAN I SWAP DAYS WITH SOMEONE ELSE ON THE ROSTER?

***YES.** You may swap Roster Duty dates with other Members on the Roster; but you have to arrange it and notify Tanya Bailey. **WE WILL NOT ARRANGE IT FOR YOU.***

### 6. I'M NOT 18 WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I'M ROSTERED ON?

*Parents or others over **18** will carry out the Roster Duty for all competitors under **18**.*

### 7. WHAT DO I DO WHEN I ARRIVE AT THE TRACK FOR MY ROSTER DUTY?

*Please report to the Race Office by 8.00am on Race Day. You must wear solid closed in shoes and a hat for all duties.*

### 8. WHAT HAPPENS IF THE RACE MEETING IS POSTPONED?

*In the event of a Race Meeting being postponed, your Roster Duty will move to the new date with the Race Meeting.*

### 9. WHAT DO I DO IF I DON'T KNOW HOW TO DO THE JOB ALLOCATED?

*Written instructions are available from the Race Office, plus the Clerk of Course will ensure you are familiar with the requirements for each job at the Officials Briefing.*

### 10. WHAT DO I DO IF I'M NOT SURE I'M DOING THE RIGHT THING?

*If at any time during the meeting (except during a race) you have any questions you may contact either the Clerk of Course or Chief Steward via your radio for assistance*

### 11. WHAT JOBS ARE ON THE ROSTER?

*Roster Duty Positions include but is not limited too: - Flags x 4 - Grid Marshall - Weigh Marshall*

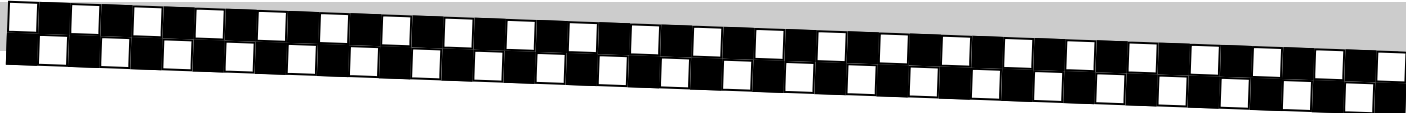
