

## Club Championship Policy

Feb 2015

### The CCSKC 2015 Club Championship Classes are –

Cadet 9, Cadet 12, Junior National Combined, Clubman Light, Clubman Heavy,  
KT Modified Light, KT Modified Heavy  
(All classes are reviewed annually at our AGM)

### Objective:

In order to qualify for Trophies & Awards pertaining to each CCSKC Club Championship Class each year, the following requirements/conditions must be met.

### Audience:

All Members of Karting Australia.

### Requirements/Conditions:

1. **Members Only**
  - a) Only financial CCSKC members are eligible to compete in the Club Championship.
  - b) Club Championship points will accrue from the first Round each year, or from the date of becoming a financial Member. You must then maintain your Membership for the remainder of the Calendar year.
  - c) Members who join part way through the year, will only have Round points qualify once they are financial. Any previous points accrued as a non-member will not be included.
  - d) Members are eligible to accrue points for multiple classes, as long as all conditions are met.
  - e) Memberships which are suspended or cancelled, will forfeit all points accrued by all members covered, in all classes.
2. **Calendar**
  - a) Each years Club Championship calendar dates are normally published by the previous years Presentation date.
  - b) Spare dates are also published, which may be used in case any Round needs to be re-scheduled.
  - c) The Club will not allocate any points, if you cannot compete in any Round, for any reason.
3. **Rounds**
  - a) The Club Championship will be run over a Maximum of 8 Rounds.
  - b) Each members Club Championship Class total will be calculated by adding all your Round point scores.
  - c) If you compete at all Rounds, your Club Championship Class total will exclude the Round with the lowest point score.
  - d) If any Rounds cannot be run, then the Maximum Rounds will reduce accordingly, and points b) and c) will apply on that reduced number.
  - e) Each member must compete in 50% or more Rounds, of each Club Championship Class run. Roster duties or Official Duties do not count towards this total.
  - f) Each Round will normally consist of 4 races per Class in total. Due to any Force Majeure event, this may be reduced, but would be done so equally across all classes.
  - g) All Round point scores count towards the Highest Point Score end of year Awards.
4. **Roster Duties**
  - a) Each member who performs their Volunteer Roster duty (as per the Roster Duty Policy) will be awarded Bonus points to be added to their Club Championship total.
  - b) Members must ensure they sign the Volunteer/Roster sheets at those Rounds.
  - c) For the 2015 year, 40 Bonus points maximum, are on offer per Member.
  - d) If running multiple classes the Member needs to nominate which class to add the Bonus points to.

**5. Official Duties**

- a) Member Officials that compete in at least 5 Club Championship Rounds, and give up their time (as a Clerk of Course or Steward) at any 1, or 2 additional Rounds, will be allocated an average (AVG) point score for those Rounds at the end of the season.
- b) The average (AVG) point score is based on the Rounds previously competed.
- c) If any Rounds are not run, then they must compete in at least the reduced number of Rounds.
- d) This will enable Member Officials to be in the running for the Club Championship Class they nominate.

**6. Club Championship Table**

- a) The member with the lowest point score each round will be highlighted for award purposes.
- b) Members who perform Volunteer Roster duties at a round will be noted, and Bonus points added to the Club Championship total.
- c) Members who perform Official duties, will nominate up to 2 rounds as AVG, until the end of season.
- d) A progressive point score table will be kept and published on the Club website.

**7. Point Score System**

- a) The Points awarded for finishing each race is as follows –

1 <sup>st</sup> = 25	8 <sup>th</sup> = 7
2 <sup>nd</sup> = 20	9 <sup>th</sup> = 6
3 <sup>rd</sup> = 16	10 <sup>th</sup> = 5
4 <sup>th</sup> = 12	11 <sup>th</sup> = 4
5 <sup>th</sup> = 10	12 <sup>th</sup> = 3
6 <sup>th</sup> = 9	13 <sup>th</sup> = 2
7 <sup>th</sup> = 8	14 <sup>th</sup> and so on = 1

- b) DNS, DNF, DSQ = 0 points.

- c) In the case of Over-subscribed classes at a Round, the heat points will be calculated as normal. However, there will be an A-Final and B-Final run. The A-Final points will be awarded as above. The B-Final points will be awarded (in order) following on from the last A-Final finisher. (I.e. If 9 drivers finish the A-Final, then the first finisher in the B-Final is awarded 10<sup>th</sup> place overall and given 5 points, the second finisher in the B-Final is awarded 11<sup>th</sup> place overall and given 4 points, and so on.)

**8. Trophies and Awards**

- a) Each Round, Trophies will be awarded to the highest 3 point scorers in each Class.
- b) Each Round an Award will be presented to the winner of the Final race in each Class.
- c) Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places to the end of year Class Champions.
- d) Trophies will also be awarded to the Highest Point Scorers – one for all Junior classes and one for all Senior classes.
- e) Other Club speciality Awards will also be reviewed and presented at end of year.
- f) Club members will be eligible to vote on some of these awards.
